Antelope Valley - The Antelope Valley Air Quality Management District has issued an Air Quality Advisory today for the Antelope Valley. This advisory will remain in effect until further notice.

Smoke from wildfires burning throughout California are forecasted to migrate south and impact the Antelope Valley. High temperatures, increased ozone and other factors are contributing to the poor air quality.

Active children and adults, and people with lung disease, such as asthma, should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion outdoors. Everyone else, especially children, should reduce prolonged or heavy exertion outdoors.
