Permits Deemed Denied

The applicant may deem an application for a permit to construct denied, and appeal such denial to the District Hearing Board pursuant to Rule 216, if the Air Pollution Control Officer has failed to either approve or deny the application for a permit to construct within the time period specified by Rule 210(d).
